Dear Interested Volunteer:

We are looking for volunteers for our January, 2014 trip and hope you will be interested in participating in the Partners for Rural Health in the Dominican Republic (PRHDR) project. Our non-profit organization, PRHDR, will be eagerly looking forward to receiving your letter of intention as well as application and project payments. Time is short, so please email me of your interest in participating as a volunteer now. There is a short "Letter of Intent" which helps us understand your specific skill set and qualifications. Please click on the Volunteer page of the website and click on the "Letter of Intent" first and email to info@prhdr.org as soon as possible. This goes to Whitney Lutz, President of PRHDR and she will review your references prior to acceptance as a volunteer. Once accepted, please fill out the Volunteer Application which you will find on the Volunteer page of the website.

We are in the planning stages for our next trip. Therefore some of the dates and arrangements may change, but we want to give you as much information as we can at the present time so you can plan to attend. This letter will be updated as we confirm the dates, flights and prices, so please check the website frequently to receive current information.

DATES: We will be going December 29th to January 11th. This <u>includes</u> flight days.

TRAVEL: For everyone within driving distance from Portland, Maine, it is strongly suggested that you fly together with our group of nursing students, providers, and interpreters since your checked baggage will contain all the medicines we bring with us and you will have to clear customs with us. You may bring one checked luggage and one carry on of your own. We will assign you another checked bag which will have medicine. It is EXTREMELY helpful if you can pack everything you need into a carry on so you can be assigned two medicine bags. If you live outside of Maine, arranging your flights to coincide with the groups is your responsibility. We will arrange for airport pick up. Please arrange to fly into either Santiago or Puerto Plata Dominican airports.

AIRLINES: GROUP FARE FROM PORTLAND:

We plan on saving 8 seats on the group flight for volunteers from Portland. Availability for seats will be first come, first served basis. Your group airfare will be **approximately \$630 with Jet Blue**. If you plan on coming with the group, please get your \$50 deposit in ASAP. This will go to reserving your seat and <u>will go towards your volunteer fee cost</u>. Be sure your name on the ticket is **exactly** the same as on your passport when you pay. We fly out of Boston the evening of the 29th and land in Santiago early in the morning. Please note the flight information:

AIRLINES: OTHER:

If you are not traveling on the group flight, then you will need to make your own arrangements for a flight. Try to arrange your flight so that you arrive around the same time as the group flight so you can ride to Lajas de Yaroa with the rest of the group if possible. We will be landing at the Santiago airport (STI) December 30th at 3:30 AM. Please let me know your flight plans as soon as possible. Travelers not connecting with the group as we travel to our destination in Lajas will be expected to pay their respective driver \$40 for transportation from Santiago airport or Puerto Plata airport. We will arrange the pick up once your airline reservations are finalized. We will be picking up rental vehicles later in the day on the 30th at Puerto Plata (POP) Airport so arriving on that day at that airport would help us immensely.

Evacuation and Medical Insurance: We require that you have this in case you have a medical emergency. This insurance covers costs rejected by your personal health insurance, evacuation for serious illness, possible travel by a family member, plus accidental death insurance and other benefits. We use Gateway International Plan for this insurance (www.GatewayPlans.com./ahins/. Most of you know there is no safe medical care in our region of the DR; Cost **is included** in the comprehensive lodging fee.

LODGING FEE will be set soon. It will be between \$600-\$700. We will let you know as soon as possible when this fee is set. A \$100.00 deposit (which will be applied to your room and board) must be received by November 1st. This will be applied towards the fee costs. An early bird discount of a savings of \$100 if all your fees are paid by **November 20th**!!!

So, if the fee is \$650 and you meet the November 20th deadline, the fee will be \$550. Final fee payment is due no later than December 1st.

Room accommodations for the entire trip including laundry and tips

All meals (except flight days, beach and hospital days),

A one day excursion trip to the beach at Cabarete,

All transportation with the group while in the DR with four-wheel drive vehicles Group costs and evacuation insurance

Please be in touch as soon as possible with PRHDR as to your plans or any changes.

You will **ALSO** need a passport (**do not skip this point!**), vaccines including hepatitis A, typhoid oral or injectable and TB skin test within a year prior to going. (Polio booster for volunteers over 40, flu shot, tetanus booster every 10 years, and hepatitis B series of 3 vaccines are recommended since even non-medical persons can be exposed to body fluids. Occasionally we have a case of traveler's diarrhea. However, but we have not seen malaria.
